Oil Overview: Update with Data Through June 2024

- Oil demand in JODI-reporting countries rose by 1.49 mb/d in June and was up 0.9 mb/d year-on-year.
 - The month-on-month gain continued to be driven mainly by gasoline, jet fuel and kerosene demand. Gasoline demand hit a new 5-year seasonal record high.
 - Diesel and LPG demand both fell month-on-month. Diesel demand was down by 0.1 kb/d m/m and by 0.91 mb/d y/y while LPG was down by 58.8 kb/d m/m and by 24.4 kb/d y/y.
- Crude oil production rose by 106 kb/d in June driven mainly by higher production from Canada, Norway and the United States.
 - Crude production was up by 55 kb/d y/y. Kuwait Crude production was down by 135 kb/d y/y while the US gained y/y 344 kb/d. Saudi Arabia Crude production data was not available for June.
 - Norway Crude production was slightly up by 47.4 kb/d in June to settle at 1.75 mb/d while its crude exports were down by 208 kb/d, m/m.
- Crude inventories retracted by 5.7 mb in June and were 233 mb below the 5-year average. Product inventories rose by 53.1 mb m/m, settling at 26.3 mb above the 5-year average.

Gas Overview: Update with Data Through June 2024

- Natural gas production rose in June by 0.7 bcm and by 3.5% year-on-year.
 - The year-on-year gain was driven by Nigeria, the United States and Canada.
- Natural gas demand rose in June m/m by 4.2 bcm and remained at a 5-year seasonal high.
 - EU+UK natural gas demand fell by 1.3 bcm m/m and settling at a 5-year seasonal low.
- Total gas inventories rose in June by 14.4 bcm, settling at a 5-year seasonal high.
 - EU+UK inventories rose by 7.3 bcm month-on-month and settled at 12.3% higher than the 5 year average.







Oil demand rose by 1.49 mb/d m/m in June, and 1.7% y/y






Gasoline demand was at a seasonal high in June while diesel demand was down by 0.9 mb/d y/y









Jet fuel demand was up in June by 44.5 kb/d m/m and by 134.6 kb/d y/y






Crude production rose by 106.3 kb/d y/y in June while NGL production was down by 52.1 kb/d y/y








Crude inventories were down by 5.7 mb in June while product inventories rose by 53.1 mb m/m







Norway's crude production rose by 47.4 kb/d in June m/m while oil exports were down by 208 kb/d






South Korea's refinery runs were down by 144.1 kb/d in June m/m and crude imports by 273.9 kb/d









Japan's crude imports fell by 125 kb/d in June m/m and refinery runs by 286.6 kb/d





India's total product demand rose by 40 kb/d in June m/m while its product exports were down by 244 kb/d










Gas production rose by 0.7 bcm in June and 3.5% y/y






Natural gas demand in June continued to surpass the 5-year seasonal levels






Natural gas inventories rose by 14.4 bcm in June and continued their upward trend higher than 5-year seasonal levels
