Oil Overview: September Update with Data Through July 2022

- Global demand declined counter-seasonally by ~1.1 mb/d.
 - Demand dropped month-on-month in July in Indonesia (-465 kb/d), India (-395 kb/d), EU+UK (-376 kb/d), Saudi Arabia (-192 kb/d), and China (-191 kb/d).
- Total gasoline demand fell counter-seasonally in July by 566 kb/d and was below the 5year average for the first time since January.
- Total diesel demand fell by 1.1 mb/d in July and was below the 5-year average for the first time since last September.
- Jet fuel demand declined for the first time since February.
- Fuel oil demand declined counter seasonally, but it was still at a five-year seasonal high.
- Product inventories increased by 62.7 mb in July vs. the seasonal norm of 17.3 mb. They remain 100.1 mb below the 5-year average.
- Crude inventories increased counter-seasonally by 9.2 mb and were 338.7 mb below the 5-year average.

Gas Overview: August Update with Data Through July 2022

- Total natural gas production in July declined counter-seasonally driven by reduced Russian production.
 - Russian gas production dropped for a 4th consecutive month to a 5-year seasonal low. July production was 34% below March levels.
- EU+UK gas consumption was at a 5-year seasonal low in July. The group's gas inventories increased by 3.9 bcm less than the seasonal average build of 9.7 bcm to stand ~63% full at the end of July.
- Total natural gas demand increased seasonally in July.
 - Robust consumption in the US and Canada more than offset weaker consumption in the EU+UK.
- Total LNG exports declined slightly in July and were in line with year-ago levels.
 - EU+UK LNG imports in July were more than double year-ago levels.
- Gas inventories increased by 15.5 bcm month-on-month in July and were 15.9 bcm below the 5-year average.

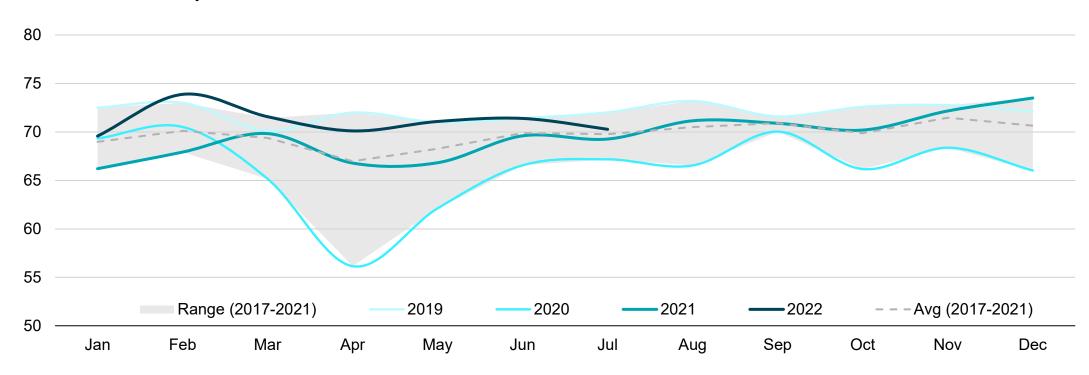

Million Barrels Per Day



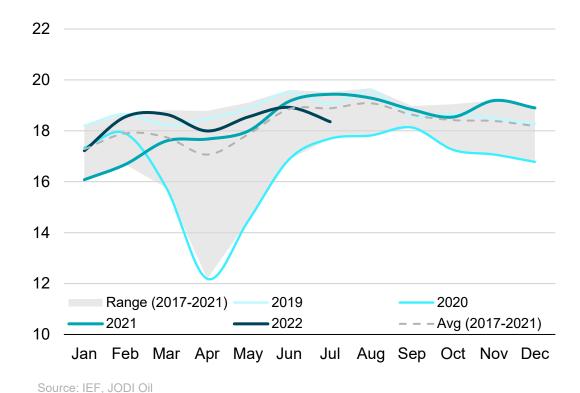

Gasoline and diesel demand fell below the 5-year average

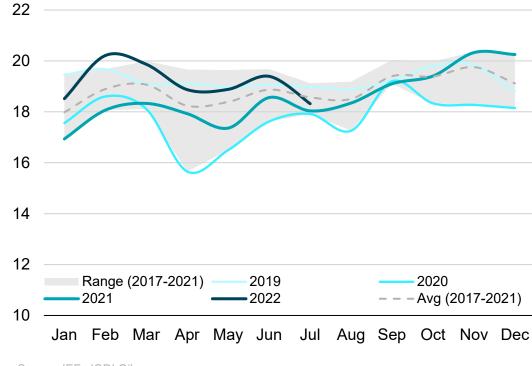
Gasoline Demand (41 Countries)

Diesel Demand (41 Countries)

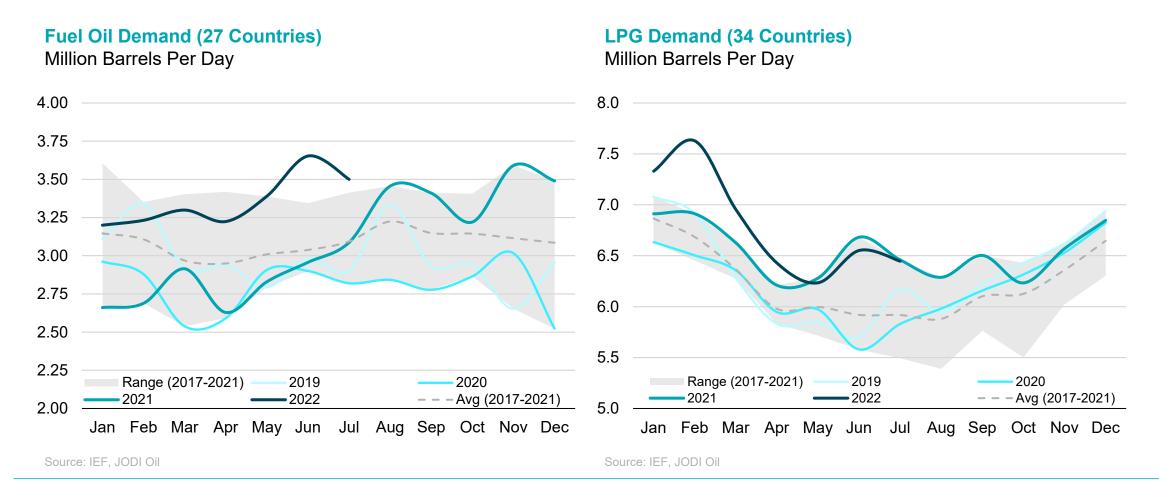

Fuel oil and LPG demand remain more robust, compared to other products

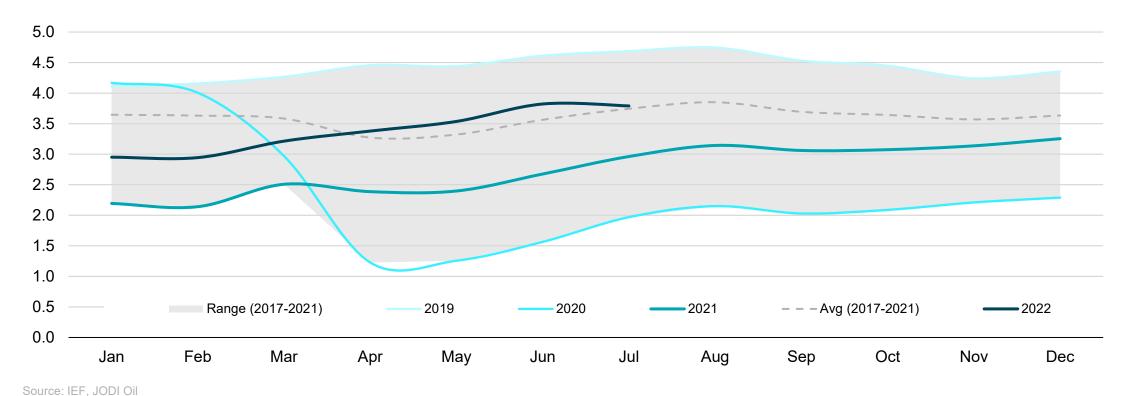




Jet fuel demand declined for the first time since February and was 19% below July 2019 levels

Million Barrels Per Day

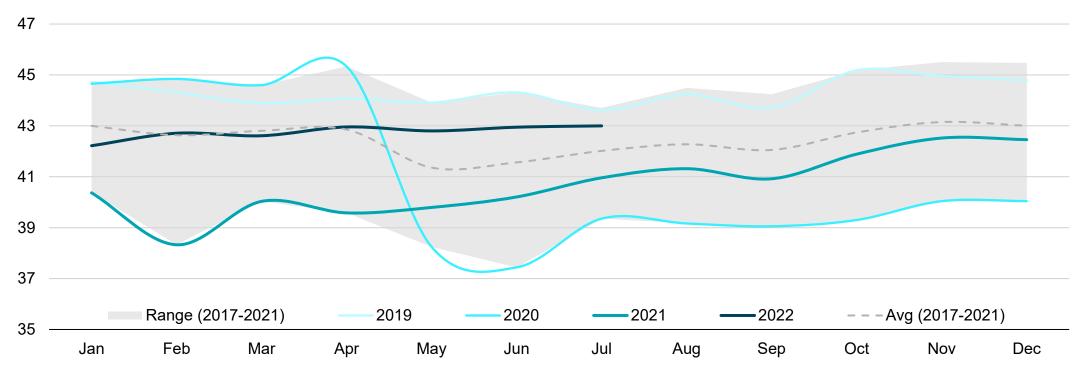




Crude production increased marginally as increases in the US and Saudi Arabia were partially offset by declines in China, Venezuela, and Nigeria

Crude Oil Production (30 Countries)

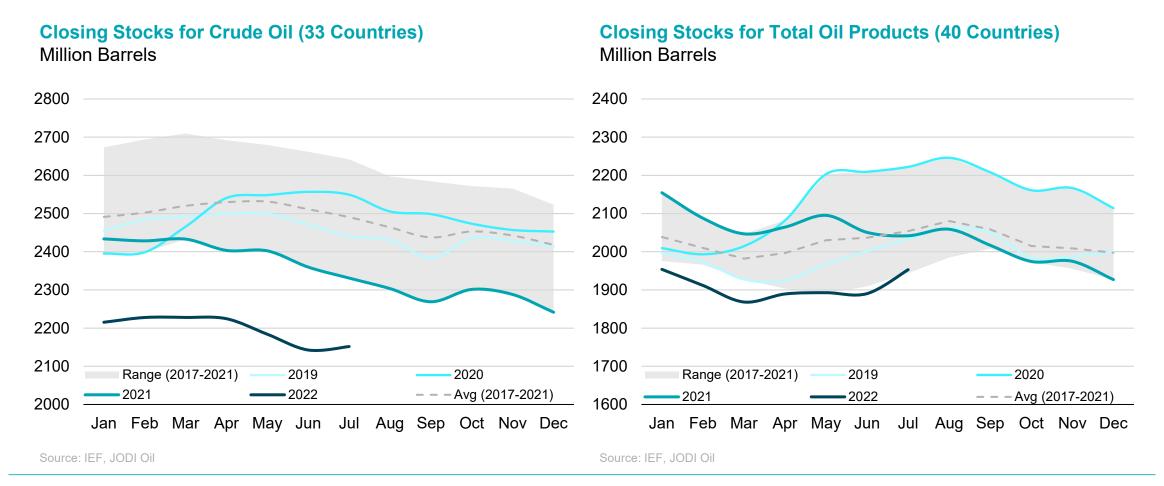

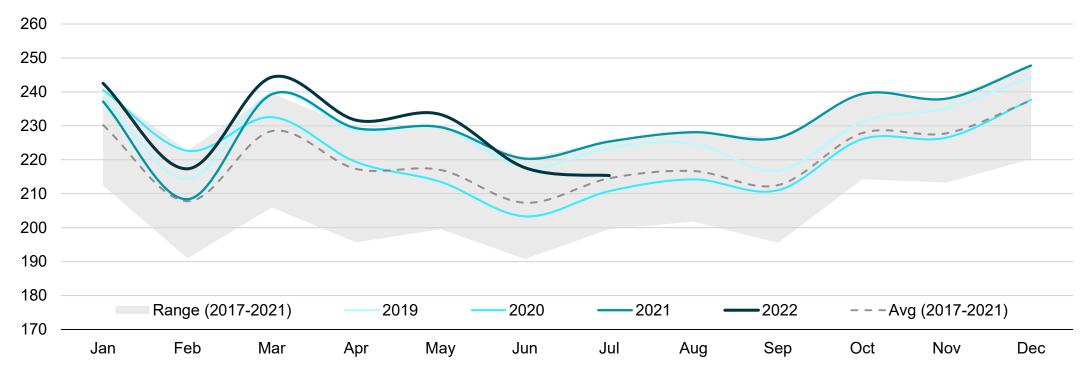

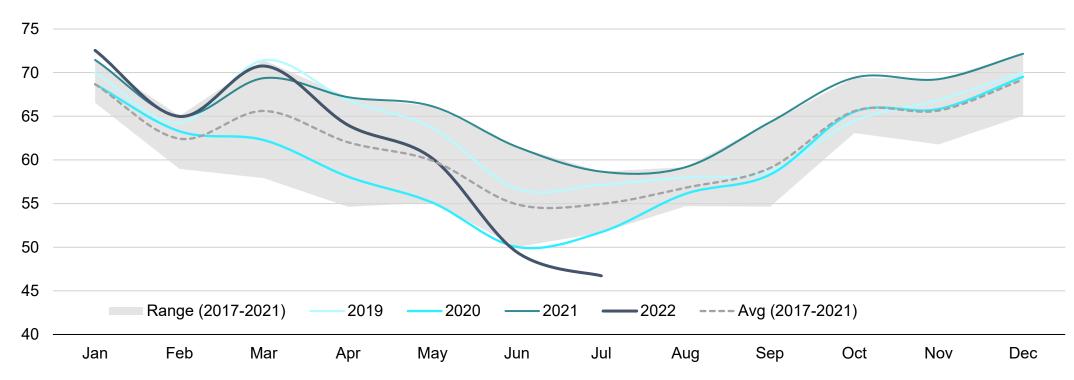




Russian natural gas production dropped for a 4th consecutive month and was 34% below March levels

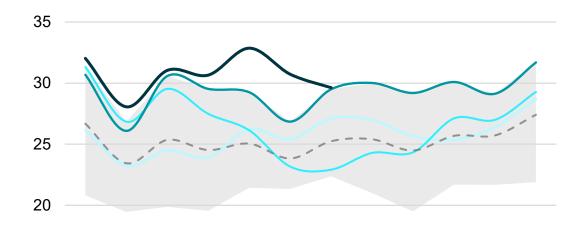


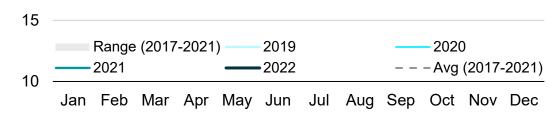


LNG exports declined slightly in July; Europe's imports were more than double year-ago levels

Billion Cubic Metres

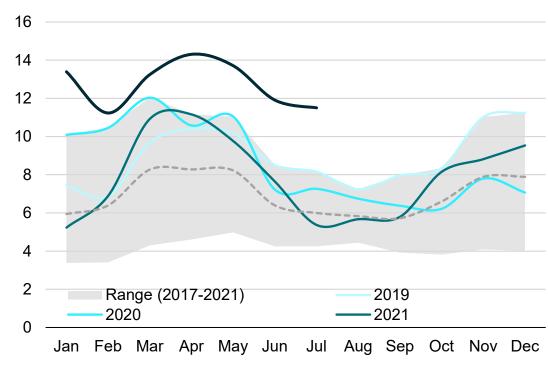

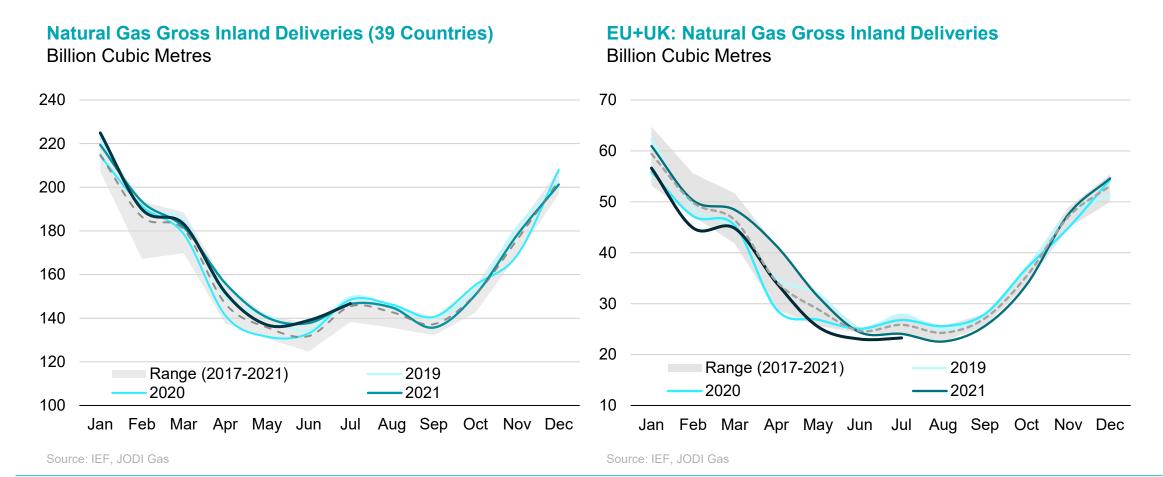
EU+UK: LNG Imports

Total gas demand increased seasonally as strong N. American demand offset weaker European demand

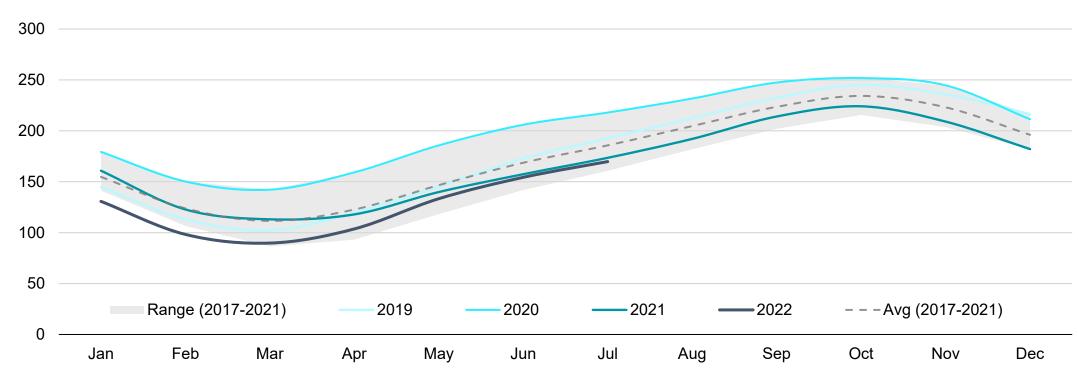




Gas inventories remain 15.9 bcm below the 5-year average at the end of July

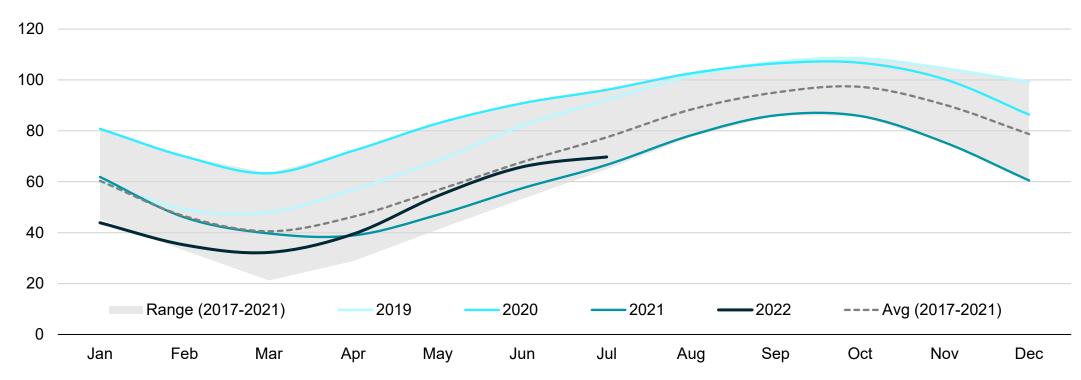




EU+UK inventories built by 3.9 bcm in July and stood 63% full at the end of the month
