#### Oil Overview: Update with Data Through July 2024

- Oil demand in JODI-reporting countries rose by 0.56 mb/d in July and was up 1.74 mb/d year-on-year.
  - The month-on-month gain is mainly driven by gasoline seasonal demand, which recorded a new 5-year historical level.
  - The monthly LPG demand gained 87 kb/d, whereas Jet fuel demand was up by 65 kb/d and Kerosene by 35 kb/d m/m.
  - Diesel in parallel, recorded a significant decrease of 0.9 mb/d m/m to settle at 14.6 mb/d in July.
- Crude oil production rose by 501 kb/d in July driven mainly by higher production from Norway, Saudi Arabia, the United Kingdom and the United States.
  - July Crude oil production was higher by 454 kb/d y/y. Canada Crude production was up by 233 kb/d y/y while the US gained 384 kb/d y/y.
  - Saudi Arabia Crude production in July was up by 111 kb/d m/m to settle at 8.9 mb/d. The crude exports were down by 306 kb/d to 5.7 mb/d.
  - Norway Crude production settled in July at 1.84 mb/d gaining 121.2 kb/d m/m. The exports reached ~1.7 mb/d and were up by ~57 kb/d, m/m.
- Crude inventories retracted by 12.5 mb in July, settling at 255 mb below the 5-year average. Product inventories rose by 46.6 mb m/m and were up by 18.6 mb above the 5-year average.

#### Gas Overview: Update with Data Through July 2024

- Natural gas production rose in July by 4.7 bcm month-on-month and was down by 1.2 bcm year-on-year.
  - The year-on-year decrease was notably driven by the United States, Egypt, Indonesia, the United Kingdom, and Canada.
- Natural gas demand rose in July by 12.9 bcm m/m, settling at higher than the 5-year seasonal average.
  - EU+UK natural gas demand rose by 1.3 bcm m/m to settle at 200.1 bcm.
- Total gas inventories rose in July by 9.7 bcm m/m, recording new historical levels in comparison to the last 5-year seasonal period.
  - EU+UK inventories rose by 7.1 bcm month-on-month and by 0.38 bcm year-on-year, settling at 7.6 bcm higher than the 5-year seasonal average.






# Oil demand rose by 0.56 mb/d m/m in July, and by 1.7 mb/d y/y






# Gasoline demand in July was higher than the 5-year seasonal levels while diesel demand fell by 0.9 mb/d m/m






# Jet fuel demand was up in July by 65.5 kb/d m/m and by 150.5 kb/d y/y






# Crude production rose by 454 kb/d y/y in July while NGL production was up by 473.5 kb/d y/y






# Crude inventories fell by 12.5 mb in July while product inventories were up by 46.6 mb m/m

#### **Total Product Closing Stocks (35 Countries)**



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


# Saudi Arabia's crude production rose by 111 kb/d in July m/m while oil exports were down by 306 kb/d






## Norway's crude production rose by 121.2 kb/d in July m/m and oil exports were up by 56.7 kb/d






# South Korea's refinery runs were up by 33.6 kb/d in July m/m and crude imports stayed almost unchanged m/m to settle at by 2.57 mb/d






## Japan's crude imports were down by 117 kb/d in July m/m and refinery runs by 90 kb/d



**Billion Cubic Metres** 



# Natural gas demand in July maintained higher records than the 5-year seasonal levels


#### **Natural Gas Demand (37 Countries)**






# Natural gas inventories rose by 9.7 bcm in July, continuing to surpass the 5-year seasonal levels
