Oil Overview: Update with Data Through September 2024

- Oil demand in JODI-reporting countries was down by 3.52 mb/d in September and was up by 1.43 mb/d year-on-year (y/y).
 - The month-on-month (m/m) decline was driven by seasonal low demand for key refined fuels following the end of summer and driving seasons.
 - Gasoline demand fell by 4.6 mb/d, while Diesel and Jet fuel by 81 kb/d and 59 kb/d respectively, m/m.
- Global Crude oil production was down by 394 kb/d in September and was up by 161 kb/d y/y.
 - The yearly global rise noted an increase in the oil production of Venezuela (+181 kb/d), Canada (+123.5 kb/d), and the United States (+ 90 kb/d)
 - Saudi Arabia Crude production in September was slightly down by 17 kb/d m/m to settle at almost 9 mb/d, the same level of September last year.
 - Norway Crude production was down by 227 kb/d m/m and by 117 kb/d y/y.
- Crude inventories rose by 5.37 mb in September, settling at 206 mb below the 5-year average. Product inventories rose by 6.8 mb m/m and exceeded the 5-year average by 12.4 mb.

Gas Overview: Update with Data Through September 2024

- Natural gas production fell in September by 8.5 bcm month-on-month (m/m) and was up by 7.6 bcm year-on-year (y/y).
 - The year-on-year growth was driven by Russia, the United States, Nigeria, Norway, Canada and Azerbaijan.
- Natural gas demand fell in September by 5.18 bcm m/m, to settle at 150.2 bcm for the JODI reporting countries.
 - •EU+UK natural gas demand rose by 3.06 bcm m/m to settle at 21.9 bcm in September.
- Total gas inventories rose in September by 9.9 bcm m/m, settling at new highs to 251 bcm.
 - EU+UK inventories rose by 2.3 bcm m/m and remained almost unchanged y/y, settling at 98.7 bcm in September.






Oil demand fell by 3.5 mb/d m/m in September, and rose by 1.4 mb/d y/y






Gasoline demand in September fell by 4.6 mb/d and diesel demand was down by 81 kb/d m/m






Jet fuel demand was down in September by 59 kb/d m/m and up by 247 kb/d y/y







Crude production rose by 161 kb/d y/y in September while NGL production rose by 293 kb/d y/y






Crude inventories rose by 5.4 mb in September while product inventories were up by 6.8 mb m/m









Saudi Arabia's crude production was slightly down by 17 kb/d in September m/m while oil exports were up by 80 kb/d








India's total product demand was up by 33 kb/d in September while total product imports were almost at the same level m/m



Billion Cubic Metres



Natural Gas Demand (47 Countries)






Natural gas inventories rose by 9.89 bcm in September, to 250.9 bcm pursuing its historical trend


